## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### Summary of Major Changes

The new electoral boundaries have effectively abolished one Brisbane and one country electorate, replaced by new electorates on the Gold and Sunshine Coasts. In Brisbane's northern suburbs, the new electorate of Stafford includes most of the abolished electorates of Chermside and Kedron, while Darling Downs has been created in place of the abolished Crows Nest and Western Downs. The two new electorates are Gaven in the Gold Coast hinterland, and Glass House in the Sunshine Coast hinterland.

While all 89 electorates have had their boundaries altered, 76 retain the same name. Nine electorates have been re-named, while there are four abolished and four new electorates. The details of new and re-named electorates are set out in the table below.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains estimates of the political impact of the new Queensland electoral boundaries, as finalised by the Queensland Redistribution Commission on 7 July 1999. Most of the analysis is based on re-assigning the results of the 1998 state election to correspond to the new boundaries. However, estimates are also provided based on the 1995 state election, and the 1998 federal election. Full details of the method of calculation used are contained in Appendix B.

### A Caution on Interpreting Figures

All votes have been assigned to new electorates on the basis of party. However, this overlooks two very important factors that can help determine the level of vote for a candidate within an electorate.

The first is that a well known sitting member can attract a higher vote than his or her party would otherwise receive. For this reason, party votes transferred in or out of an electorate may not accurately reflect the level of vote the party will receive in the new electorate. Secondly, marginal seats tend to see much more intense campaigns than safe seats. Votes transferred reflect the intensity of campaign on the old electoral boundaries, which may not be repeated in any campaign on the new boundaries.

For both of these reasons, all quoted margins and percentage votes must be taken as guides only. The outcome of the next election will be determined by the candidates and parties contesting the new electorates, not past voting patterns.

### Reading the Tables

The tables of electorate details provided in Section 3 give a complete breakdown for each new electorate, based on the 1998 election results. It includes a full listing of booths and declaration votes transferred to each new electorate. Separate sub-totals are provided for each transfer of voters from an old electorate, as well as a grand total for the new electorate. Consider the following example from the listing for Albert

The line beginning "Transfers ..." indicates from which electorate votes have been transferred. The figure in brackets (17701) is the number of electors transferred, as provided by the Redistribution Commission.

In this example, the next two lines list the names of the polling places that have been transferred from the old electorate of Albert to the new. In the case of the Coomera booth, only 50% has been transferred. The percentage of Declaration votes transferred is indicated in the same way. A separate entry is provided for each transfer of voters from an old to a new electorate, and a grand total for each new electorate is also provided.

The column headed VOTES is the total votes transferred, and includes informal votes. It is NOT the sum of the formal votes on the line. Note that because of optional preferential voting, the total of the two-party preferred votes might not equal the total of the primary votes. A total of votes and percentage votes for each party is provided, representing the sum of the booth and declaration votes transferred. A sub-total is provided for each old electorate from which electors have been transferred, as well as a grand total for the new electorate.

### Presentation of Results

In presenting results, electorates have been grouped into four sub-tables, representing abolished electorates (4), new electorates (4), re-named electorates (9) and continuing electorates (76).

### By-Elections

By-elections have been ignored in all calculations. In particular, note that this publication does not take account of the February 1996 Mundingburra re-election, or the December 1998 Mulgrave by-election.

### Resignation of MPs from One Nation

All analysis of the 1998 state election is based on the votes cast for parties at that election. For this reason, no account has been taken of the subsequent resignation of several One Nation MPs from that political party.

### Notes on Estimating New Margins

Estimating the final two-candidate preferred vote for each new electorate is difficult, because many of the new electorates include two-candidate preferred votes from old electorates with different combinations of final two parties. Calculating a new margin therefore requires assumptions about how preferences would have been distributed in the new electorate.

As an example, the new electorate of Barron River includes votes from the old Barron River, which finished as a contest between Labor and Liberal candidates, and from Cairns, which was a contest between Labor and One Nation candidates. The primary votes in the new Barron River indicate the electorate would have been a contest between Labor and Liberal candidates, and so assumptions need to be made about the preference distribution for One Nation votes transferred from Cairns.

The method adopted has been to redistribute the votes of the areas added to the electorate using the distribution of preferences of the electorate into which the votes have been transferred. In the case of Barron River, the vote for One Nation transferred from Cairns has been distributed between Labor and Liberal candidates using the actual distribution of preferences from Barron River.

Full details of all electorates where assumptions have had to be made about preferences can be found in Appendix B.

## 4. ANALYSIS BASED ON 1995 QUEENSLAND ELECTION

The rise of One Nation meant that the 1998 state election was not a two-party contest between Labor and the National/Liberal Party Coalition. To try and measure the political impact of the new boundaries in two-party terms, it has been necessary to use the 1995 state election results, and the following tables summarise the results of these calculations.

These tables do not use the results of the Mundingburra re-election from February 1996, but are based on the 1995 election results.

## 5. ANALYSIS BASED ON 1998 FEDERAL ELECTION

As with the analysis based on state election results, calculations based on the 1998 Federal election have been carried out by transferring booths, this time from Federal electorates to state electorates. However, estimates are based on booth results only. Declaration votes (postal, absent etc) have not been included.

Because of the different pattern of Liberal and National Party support at Federal elections, no attempt has been made to define seats as being either Liberal or National Party held. All Coalition seats are indicated with LNP, meaning Liberal-National Party seat.

In the Federal electorate of Blair, the booth figures used have been the two-party preferred results between Labor and Liberal candidates, not the two-candidate preferred results between Liberal and One Nation candidates.

Because there is a considerable difference between the Labor vote at the 1998 Federal election and the two state elections, the holding of seats by each party is not directly comparable. However, the following two tables summarise the relative positions of the parties on the old and new boundaries.

State and federal election are fought on very different issues, so translating Federal election results to the state boundaries does not give any indication of possible voting patterns at a State election. However, the exercise does give a measure of the shift in margin created by the change in boundaries for each election.

These shifts in margin are included in the tables in Section 6, along with similar shifts based on the 1995 and 1998 state elections.

## APPENDIX B: DETAILS OF METHODOLOGY AND CALCULATIONS

To calculate the political impact of the new electoral boundaries, the results of the previous elections have to be re-assigned to the new boundaries. This required a series of assumptions and calculations to be made concerning two-party preferred results by booth, the transfer of booths to new electorates, and the allocation of declaration votes between new electorates.

### Calculating Two-Candidate Preferred Results by Booth

Before calculating the redistribution, it was first necessary to produce two-candidate preferred results for each polling place used at both the 1995 and 1998 state elections. This was not necessary for the 1998 federal election, as actual two-candidate preferred results by booth were available.

The method adopted was to apply the distribution of preferences for the electorate as a whole to each polling place result. Candidates were eliminated in the same order as for the electorate as a whole, and the same flows of preferences applied.

This process is best explained by the following example for the electorate of Callide. The votes for each candidate, and the successive distribution of preferences are displayed in the table below.

Note that in this case, despite the Labor candidate having the highest primary votes, his preferences have been distributed in accordance with the distribution of the electorate as a whole.

In calculating the two-candidate preferred estimates, minor rounding errors can occur. As a result, in some electorates the total of the two-candidate preferred results by booth may not add to the actual result for the electorate. However, the differences amount to no more than a handful of votes.

## Two-Candidate versus Two-Party Preferred Results

Over the past two decades, it has become standard practice for all Australian electoral bodies to carry out a full distribution of preferences, even where this is not required to determine the winning candidate in an electorate. The vote for the final two candidates after this distribution of preferences is normally referred to as the *two-candidate preferred vote*.

In most cases, this will be the same as the *two-party preferred vote*, which is usually defined as the final count after the distribution of preferences between the final candidate representing the Labor Party, and the National/Liberal Party coalition.

In some cases this is not the case. In 1995, the two-candidate and two-party preferred votes were not the same in the electorate of Gladstone, and at the 1998 federal election, in the electorate of Blair. At the 1998 state election, there were in fact only 53 electorates that finished as a contest between Labor and the Coalition, One Nation finishing first or second in 34 electorates, with another two being contests won by Independents.

As the 1998 state election was clearly not a two-party contest, no attempt has been made in this publication to convert it into a two-party contest between Labor and the Coalition. Some measure of the boundaries' impact on the two-party contest can be assessed from the re-calculation of the 1995 state and 1998 federal election results shown in Sections 4 and 5.

## Transferring Booths to New Electorates

All tables have been prepared by re-assigning the booths used at previous elections to each of the new electorates. Once all booths had been re-assigned, and a proportion of declaration votes transferred, the vote by party for each new electorate was calculated by simply adding up the transferred booths and votes.

The decision on transferring a booth to a new electorate was made by examining the maps provided by the Queensland Redistribution Commission. Where a polling place was close to a new boundary, consideration was given to splitting the booth between electorates. A check was made to ensure that the number of votes transferred correlated with the number of electors transferred. This was made possible by the numbers of electors being transferred from each old to new electorate being made available to me by Queensland Electoral Commissioner Mr Des O'Shea. These numbers are included at the end of this Appendix.

At all times, the number of votes transferred has been kept in the range 90-95% of the number of voters transferred. This roughly corresponds to the turnout in each electorate at the state election. In electorates with a low turnout, or where there had been enrolment growth since the state election, the ratio was allowed to fall as low as 85%.

## Transferring Declaration Votes

All postal, pre-poll, absent, electoral visit and declared institution votes in an electorate, as well as all votes cast at Brisbane City Hall (except for the electorate of Brisbane Central) have been grouped together as declaration votes. These have been transferred from each old electorate to each new electorate in direct proportion to the number of voters transferred between the electorates.

For instance, 20.8% of voters in the electorate of Burdekin were transferred to Mundingburra, 1.0% to Charters Towers, with 78.2% remaining in the new Burdekin. Declaration votes have been distributed to the new electorates in the same proportion.

However, the relative proportion of votes for each party has been weighted according to the vote in the booths transferred using the following method. As a first step, the ratio of declaration votes to booth votes for each old electorate was calculated, as in the following example.

These ratios were then applied to the votes transferred to new electorates. For instance two booths were transferred from Burdekin to Mundingburra. The 20.8% of the Declaration vote transferred to Mundingburra was then weighted to reflect the vote in these booths, using the method outlined below.

In this case, the Labor vote in booths transferred to Mundingburra was 36.19%. Applying the ratio of 0.9603, the Labor percentage of Declaration votes to be transferred is 34.75%. After rounding so the percentages add to 100%, this becomes 34.27% of formal declaration votes. So of the 20.8% of declaration votes transferred to Mundingburra, 34.27% will be Labor Party votes, as compared to the 30.45% Labor vote in the overall Declaration vote for Burdekin.

This process may seem unduly complex, but it ensures that the declaration votes transferred reflects the political complexion of the areas involved. In the case of Burdekin, the Declaration votes transferred to Mundingburra will have a higher proportion of Labor votes than those that remain in Burdekin, which reflects the political complexion of the booths transferred. Overall, the sum of the declaration votes transferred to the three electorates will still add to the total declaration vote recorded for Burdekin.

In some remote rural electorates, where a large proportion of declaration votes are remote postal votes, this method may not fully reflect the true transfer of votes. However, without better knowledge of the exact numbers of postal and absent votes transferred, the above method is the best available.

The same calculations have been used to transfer votes for the 1995 election. However, the large increase in enrolments between 1995 and 1999 may make these estimates less reliable.

Estimates based on the 1998 federal election DO NOT include any declaration votes. All estimates are based on the transfer of booths only.

### Calculating Two-Candidate Preferred Results for 1998 Election

As the detailed tables in Section 3 show, calculations for many of the new electorates do not produce a clear-cut contest between two candidates and parties. As a result, assumptions about the distribution of preferences have had to be made to produce the summary tables shown in Section 2. The following list provides details of the assumptions made in calculating an estimated two-candidate preferred result for each electorate where this was required.
