

**REPRESENTATIVES OF QUEENSLAND STATE ELECTORATES 1860 - 2017**

**Albert**

First used as an electorate name under the 1887 redistribution, it survived successive boundary alterations until 1949, when the Darlington and Southport electorates were created. The name was revived in 1959 and retained in the 1971 and 1977 redistributions, though covering a greatly reduced area. Minor changes were made in 1991, including the loss of Carbrook in the north and coastal areas below Paradise Point in the south.

In the 1991 redistribution, the suburb of Inala was removed and parts of the suburbs of Salisbury, Coopers Plains and Algester added. The seat was abolished in the 1999 redistribution.

Metropolitan electorate created in the 1959 redistribution from the former electorate of Chermiside. In the 1991 redistribution the electorate moved north, losing Chermiside and gaining Bald Hills, Strathpine, Murrumba Downs and Griffin.

**Auburn**

Introduced in the 1971 redistribution for an area in the Western Burnett area which was previously mainly included in the electorate of Mackenzie. Abolished in the 1991 redistribution with most of the electorate subsumed in an enlarged Callide and to a lesser extent in the new electorate of Fitzroy.

**Balonne**

Constituted by the Electoral Districts Act of 1872 it continued in use until the 1931 redistribution when the electorates were reduced to 62. The name was again used in the 1949 redistribution and the area covered remained basically the same until 1991, centred around St. George and Dirranbandi. Abolished in the 1991 redistribution with the electorate distributed among the new electorate of Western Downs and the existing electorate of Warrego.

### **Barambah**

Introduced in the 1949 redistribution for a new seat principally constituted from the former electorate of Nanango. Extended in the 1991 redistribution to include Nanango Shire. In the 1999 redistribution Barambah was abolished.

### **Barcoo**

Created by the Additional Members Act of 1885 which divided the electorate of Mitchell into Barcoo and Mitchell, the name survived successive boundary changes until the 1971 redistribution when much of the former seat was incorporated into Belyando.

### **Baroona**

Constituted under provisions of Section 14 of the Electoral Districts Act of 1931, which gave power to make alterations in boundaries. Baroona was proclaimed an electorate on 20th August 1935, operative from May of that year. It was abolished as a seat in the 1977 redistribution being incorporated into Brisbane Central, Ithaca and Ashgrove.

### **Barron River**

Introduced in the 1971 redistribution, for a new seat taking in the northern part of the city of Cairns and surrounding rural areas formerly in the electorate of Cook. The area of the electorate was significantly reduced in 1991, losing Daintree, Mossman and Port Douglas in the north and gaining Kuranda to the west. The 2008 redistribution transferred coastal areas

(Ellis Beach, Palm Cove and Clifton Beach) from the Cook electorate into Barron River electorate.

Created in the 1991 redistribution from large parts of the former Fassifern electorate. Named after the shire whose boundaries almost exactly match the electorate bounds.

Constituted under the 1949 Electoral Districts Act principally from the former Barcoo and Normanby electorates, the name was dropped in the 1959 redistribution when Barcoo was enlarged eastward. The name was revived in 1971 and dropped in 1977 in favour of Peak Downs.

**Blackall**

Formed under provisions of the 1872 Electoral Districts Act this electorate took in all the rural environs of Rockhampton from the coast to the ranges, and was split up for new electorates of Fitzroy, Normanby and Rockhampton North.

**Bowen**

Created in the 1872 Electoral Districts Act, it survived successive redistributions until 1949 when the electorate was split up. Reconstituted in the 1959 redistribution, it was once again abolished in the 1971 redistribution, but re-formed in 1986 from portions of the Peak Downs, Flinders and Whitsunday electorates. It was again dropped in 1991, divided among Whitsunday, Mirani, Burdekin, Fitzroy and Charters Towers.

**Bremer**

Existing as a separate electorate under the Electoral Districts Act of 1872, Bremer was taken into the Ipswich electorate under provisions of the 1878 Act, which gave dual representatives to the enlarged seat. Reconstituted under the 1910 Electoral Districts Act, it was dropped in 1959 when the major part of the electorate was re-named Ipswich East.

**Brisbane**

The "Town of Brisbane" and the "Town of South Brisbane" were two of the original electorates set up under the Order-in-Council of 6th June 1859. Except for the 1949 and 1986 redistributions the Brisbane River was the "natural" boundary of these electorates, and under this heading the successive electorates for the central city are listed in chronological sequence. Similar treatment is given under SOUTH BRISBANE, for the variants relevant to that area.

**Brisbane Central**

Formed by the amalgamation of portions of the former seats of Baroona and Brisbane in the 1977 redistribution. In 1986, the new boundaries crossed the Brisbane River taking in parts of the former seat of South Brisbane. In the 1991 redistribution it lost the area south of the river and gained most of the former electorate of Merthyr and the suburbs of Wilston, Windsor and part of Newmarket to the north.

### Bundamba

First used as an electorate name in the Electoral Districts Act of 1872 which changed the old Ipswich seat from a three member constituency to a single member electorate. The electorate was known as Bundamba until the name was dropped in the 1910 redistribution in favour of Bremer. The name was revived in the 1991 redistribution, with the new electorate replacing the former electorate of Wolston as well as incorporating part of the electorate of Ipswich.

Originally a single member electorate created under the 1872 Electoral Districts Act, it was changed to a two member constituency from 1888 to 1892 when it was divided into two electorates - Burke and Croydon. The Burke electorate was amalgamated in the 1931 redistribution into Carpentaria, only to be revived in the 1959 redistribution. In 1971 the name of the electorate was changed to Mount Isa.

**Burnett**

One of the sixteen original electorates proclaimed under the Order-in-Council of 6 June 1859 returning two members. By the 1872 Electoral Districts Act it was reduced to a single member constituency from 1873 until 1932 when the name was dropped as a result of the 1931 redistribution. The electorate was largely incorporated into Wide Bay (1931) and Marodian (1949) before being revived for the 1960 election. The 1991 redistribution extended this electorate north to include part of the former electorate of Callide and east to include part of the abolished electorate of Isis.

**Burrum**

Created under the Electoral Districts Act of 1887, the electorate occupied the rural environs of the Maryborough district excluding the city itself. Succeeding redistributions changed the boundaries, but the name was retained until the 1931 Electoral Districts Act resulted in its disappearance, with the area being divided between Isis and Wide Bay.

**Wooloongabba**

### Yeronga

In the 1991 redistribution the western extension of the seat was included in the new electorate of Indooroopilly while part of South Brisbane to the north was included in Yeronga. The seat was abolished in the 1999 redistribution.
