- [#] On 4 April 2011, former Brisbane Lord Mayor Campbell Newman was elected to lead the LNP to the 2012 Queensland state election. However, Mr Newman was not recognised as Leader of the LNP by the Speaker of the Queensland Legislative Assembly because he was not a Member of Parliament. His leadership of the party was officially recognised with his appointment as Premier by gazette notice of 26 March 2012.

- * On 18 August 1999, Justice Atkinson of the Supreme Court ruled that Pauline Hanson's One Nation Party was not entitled to registration as a political party in Queensland under s 70 of the *Electoral Act 1992* (Qld) and the party was de-registered on 19 August 1999. However, the parliamentary members retained the title until their resignations from the party on 14 December 1999. The party was re-registered on 23 January 2001. See One Nation Queensland Division.

City Country Alliance Queensland*#

- * The City Country Alliance Queensland Party was formed on 22 December 1999 and was officially registered on 28 March 2000.
- # On 5 August 1999, the Independent member for Burdekin, Jeff Knuth officially registered a party called Country Party Queensland. Later, he merged his party with the City Country Alliance Party and the CPQ was officially reregistered on 2 May 2000.

- * Formed by the Member for Beaudesert Mr Aidan McLindon after his resignation from the Liberal National Party in May 2010, The Queensland Party was officially registered on 3 August 2010. On 9 August 2010 Mr McLindon announced plans to join forces with federal Member of Parliament Mr Bob Katter's newly-formed, nationally-based party, under the name Katter's Australian Party. The merger was opposed by other Queensland Party members and Mr McLindon officially resigned his membership on 12 August 2011, leaving the party without a representative in the Legislative Assembly. The party was officially deregistered on 12 December 2011 due to insufficient membership numbers under the provisions of Part 6 of the *Electoral Act 1992* (Qld).

- * Although initially formed as a national party by federal Member for Parliament Mr Bob Katter, Katter's Australian Party (Queensland Division) was officially registered with the Electoral Commission Queensland on 22 September 2011, prior to its equivalent official national registration as Katter's Australia Party on 27 September 2011. Mr McLindon was established as the leader of Katter's Australian Party (Queensland Division), while Mr Katter remained leader of the nationally registered party.
