RESIDENTIAL TENANCIES AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2)

Mr DAVIDSON (Noosa—LP) (5.13 p.m.): The Opposition will not oppose these amendments. In her second-reading speech, the Minister recalled that the Residential Tenancies Amendment Act 1998 was passed with bipartisan support in May last year, that the amendments to the Act were to commence on 1 December 1998 and were to apply to all new tenancy agreements signed on or after that date. The Opposition is aware that the Scrutiny of Legislation Committee has raised some issues with the Minister and that she will be moving some amendments at the Committee stage. We are happy to support those amendments. As I said, we offer our bipartisan support for the Bill. We will not be opposing it.
