## ZILLMERE COMMUNITY SPORTS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITY

**Mr ROBERTS** (Nudgee—ALP) (7.16 p.m.): I am pleased to advise of a momentous decision for my electorate. Sports Minister, Bob Gibbs, has approved the construction of a \$1m community sport and recreational facility for Zillmere and surrounding communities. It will be constructed on the grounds of the North Star Sports Club in Jennings Street, Zillmere.

I particularly thank the Minister and acknowledge him, his staff and departmental officers for being part of a great decision. This decision confirms that the Labor Government has a heart—a big heart. The Zillmere community could not have raised the significant funds required to comply with the dollar-for-dollar funding guidelines of this program.
