GOVERNMENT PUBLIC RELATIONS

Hon. R. E. BORBIDGE (Surfers Paradise—NPA) (Leader of the Opposition) (10.18 a.m.): Events over the last few days have clearly demonstrated that this is a Government that is all spin and no substance. Indeed, the leaked public relations strategy from the office of the Deputy Premier, disowned by the Treasurer, shows how deceitful this Government is prepared to be.

Mr ELDER: The Leader of the Opposition can have his go. It was not leaked. I find the remark untrue and I want it withdrawn.

Mr BORBIDGE: In view of the assurance given by the Deputy Premier, we will just have to assume that the Treasurer leaked it. If the Deputy Premier did not leak it, the Treasurer must have leaked it.

Mr SPEAKER: Just withdraw first and we will be right.

Mr BORBIDGE: Whoever leaked it, we have this brilliant public relations strategy—
