## MINISTERIAL STATEMENT

**Hon. T. McGRADY** (Mount Isa—ALP) (Minister for Police and Corrective Services and Minister Assisting the Premier on the Carpentaria Minerals Province) (10.20 a.m.), by leave: At the conclusion of my first ministerial statement this morning, I was called outside the chamber by one of my staff members who has forwarded to me some additional information on the subject which I referred to. The Acting Residential Manager at Wolston Corrective Services Centre, Mr Mark Granville, received information from an outside instructor that a prisoner in his group stated that there are a few prisoners upset by the fact that prisoner Clancy, who is alleged to be a knuckle man, is receiving \$250 per week into an outside bank account on a weekly basis for the protection of prisoner D'Arcy. I have immediately referred this matter to the CJC and, as I speak, the Acting Director-General of the Department of Corrective Services, Mr Peter Severin, is speaking to Mr Steve Harding of the Complaints Division of the CJC advising that a document is on its way. As I mentioned, I have taken the first opportunity to place this information before the parliament.
