## MINISTERIAL STATEMENT

### Torres Strait Islands, Safety of Public Servants

**Hon. S ROBERTSON** (Stretton—ALP) (Minister for Health) (7.30 pm), by leave: This morning I advised that the investigation into the Torres Strait had been delayed due to further information provided by one of the key personnel involved which resulted in the CMC having to go back and conduct further inquiries. In actual fact, it was the Ethical Standards Unit of Queensland Health that had to conduct further inquiries rather than the CMC. The investigation was undertaken by the Ethical Standards Unit with the CMC monitoring the outcomes. I seek leave to correct the record so that it is on record about the accuracy of the investigations that are underway into a very important matter in the Torres Strait.
