NOTICE OF MOTION

Recreational and Commercial Fishing

Mr LANGBROEK (Surfers Paradise—LNP) (Leader of the Opposition) (10.30 am): I give notice that I shall move—

That this House recognises the importance of recreational and commercial fishing and associated industries to Queensland and opposes the secrecy of the deal between the Greens and the federal Labor Party that will close off a minimum of 30 per cent of Australian waters to fishing.

Mr SPEAKER: The House has before it two notices of motion. I would ask the Leader of the House to indicate which one the government will accept.

Ms SPENCE: The government will accept the motion from the Leader of the Opposition.
