Auditor-General Strategic Plan

 **Mr CRANDON** (Coomera—LNP) (10.00 am): I wish to table an update for the Legislative Assembly regarding the work of the Auditor-General. The Finance and Administration Committee is required under the Auditor-General Act to liaise with the Auditor-General with regard to the preparation of his strategic audit plan. The committee will be consulting with the other portfolio committees and the Committee of the Legislative Assembly as part of this process.

The Auditor-General's first strategic audit plan was due to be published by 1 July 2012. The act allows for another date to be agreed between the Auditor-General and the committee. The Auditor-General has requested, in view of the timing of the election, the subsequent reconstitution of the committee system and the government's decision to defer the budget until September, an extension for the finalisation of the plan until 30 September 2012. In line with section 87 of the act, the committee has agreed to this request and the date for the first strategic audit plan will now be 30 September 2012.
