WORKERS' COMPENSATION AND REHABILITATION AND OTHER LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL: ALLOCATION OF TIME LIMIT ORDER

Mr STEVENS (Mermaid Beach—LNP) (Leader of the House) (11.23 pm), by leave, without notice: I move—

That, under the provisions of standing order 137, the Workers' Compensation and Rehabilitation and Other Legislation Amendment Bill having already been declared an urgent bill, the following time limits apply to enable the bill to be passed through its remaining stages at this day's sitting—

- (a) consideration in detail to be completed by 11.57 pm;
- (b) third reading by 11.58 pm; and
- (c) long title agreed by 12 am.

If the stage has not been completed by the time specified, Madam Speaker shall put all remaining questions necessary to pass the bill, including clauses and schedules en bloc and any amendments to be moved by the minister in charge of the bill, without further amendment or debate.
