Mr PITT (Mulgrave—ALP) (2.01 pm): After reviewing a speech I made yesterday, a typographical error led to a misstatement. For the benefit of *Hansard*, what should have been said was—

What were the interest costs the Treasurer inherited from Labor? Well, they were \$0.5 billion per year lower—before the Newman government's \$14.6 billion increase in debt. So the Treasurer is committing to lower interest costs to levels under the previous Labor government.
