## Auditor-General's Reports, Referral to Portfolio Committee; Portfolio Committees, Reporting Dates

**Mr STEVENS** (Mermaid Beach—LNP) (Leader of the House) (7.30 pm): I advise the House of determinations made by the Committee of the Legislative Assembly at its meeting today. The committee has resolved that, pursuant to standing order 194B, the Auditor-General's report to parliament No. 18 of 2013-14 titled *Monitoring and reporting performance* be referred to the Finance and Administration Committee for consideration and the Auditor-General's report to parliament No. 1 of 2014-15 titled *Results of audits: internal control systems 2013-14* be referred to the Finance and Administration Committee for consideration. The committee has also resolved pursuant to standing order 136 that the Health and Community Services Committee report on the Family Responsibilities Commission Amendment Bill by 1 October 2014 and to vary the time for the State Development, Infrastructure and Industry Committee to report on the Liquid Fuel Supply (Ethanol) Amendment Bill from 3 October 2014 to 24 October 2014.
