 **Mr KING** (Kallangur—ALP) (10.13 am): I lay upon the table of the House report No. 15 of the Transportation and Utilities Committee titled *Public Health (Water Risk Management) Amendment Bill 2016*.

The committee has unanimously agreed to recommend the bill be passed. After examination of the bill, the committee has agreed to recommend part 2 of the bill relating to the proposed amendment of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Communities (Justice, Land and Other Matters) Act 1984 be passed. The committee was not able to reach agreement on parts 3 to 5 of the bill relating to the proposed amendment of the Electricity Act 1994, the Government Owned Corporations Act 1993 and the Judicial Review Act 1991. Government members support and non-government members do not support this section of the bill.

On behalf of the committee, I would like to thank those individuals and organisations who lodged written submissions and provided evidence at the public hearing. I would once again also like to thank the committee secretariat, Queensland Treasury and the Department of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships for their assistance. I also commend this report to the House.
