Cognate Debate

 **Hon. SJ HINCHLIFFE** (Sandgate—ALP) (Leader of the House) (5.27 pm), by leave, without notice: I move—

1. the Legal Affairs and Community Safety Committee consider and report on the Fire and Emergency Services (Domestic Smoke Alarms) Amendment Bill 2016 and the Fire and Emergency Services (Smoke Alarms) Amendment Bill 2015 together;
2. under the provisions of standing order 136, the Legal Affairs and Community Safety Committee report to the House on the Fire and Emergency Services (Domestic Smoke Alarms) Amendment Bill 2016 and the Fire and Emergency Services (Smoke Alarms) Amendment Bill 2015 by 23 May 2016;
3. in accordance with standing order 172, the bills be treated as cognate for their remaining stages in the House as follows:
 - (a) second reading debate, with separate questions being put in regard to the second readings;
 - (b) the consideration of the bills in detail together; and
 - (c) separate questions being put for the third readings and long titles;
4. notwithstanding anything contained in the standing and sessional orders:
 - (a) the time limits and order for moving the second readings shall be: the Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services and Minister for Corrective Services—60 minutes, followed by the member for Kawana—60 minutes; and
 - (b) the time limits and order for reply to the second readings debate shall be: member for Kawana—30 minutes, followed by the Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services and Minister for Corrective Services—30 minutes;
5. standing order 136(6) be suspended for the Fire and Emergency Services (Smoke Alarms) Amendment Bill 2015 to allow the commencement of the second reading debate if three calendar months has not elapsed since the tabling of the portfolio committee report.
