### **NOTICE OF MOTION**

## **Construction Industry, Industrial Organisations**

Mr NICHOLLS (Clayfield—LNP) (Leader of the Opposition) (10.13 am): I give notice that I will move—

#### That this House:

- 1. notes that more than 900 workers took part in an illegal strike at the Sunshine Coast University Hospital site at the behest of the union masters in the CFMEU and ETU late last week;
- 2. notes that the opening of the new 738-bed facility has already been delayed under the Palaszczuk Labor government;
- notes that lawlessness and militant union activity has been rife in the construction sector since Bill Shorten abolished the Australian Building and Construction Commission in 2012;
- 4. notes that Queensland has more strikes in the construction industry than the rest of the country; and
- 5. supports the reintroduction of the Australian Building and Construction Commission to restore the rule of law to Queensland constriction sites, creating jobs and boosting productivity for thousands of workers.
