NOTICE OF MOTION

Palaszczuk Labor Government, LNP Plan

Mrs FRECKLINGTON (Nanango—LNP) (Leader of the Opposition) (10.13 am): I give notice that I will move—

That this House calls on the Palaszczuk Labor government to support the LNP's plan to—

- introduce retail competition, allowing regional Queenslanders to shop around and save \$300 a year on their electricity bills:
- (b) open up the Galilee Basin and create a Queensland Infrastructure Fund;
- (c) attract resource investment, with more jobs and better job security for the resources industry with a 10-year freeze on royalty rates;
- (d) increase business investment and create more local jobs by guaranteeing no new taxes;
- (e) fight crime with a dedicated police helicopter based in Townsville;
- (f) establish a Townsville based Queensland dam company to plan, design and build more dams;
- (g) deliver water security by getting the Burdekin Falls Dam project shovel ready;
- reintroduce breach of bail as an offence to hold repeat young offenders accountable for their crimes and scrap Labor's failed bail houses;
- (i) help parents protect their kids with a public sex offender register and tougher sentences for child killers;
- (j) introduce a royal commission into the building industry and subcontractor payments;
- (k) tackle the ice epidemic with a new drug rehabilitation and detox facility in Townsville to help those struggling with addiction;
- (I) back heavy engineering and manufacturing jobs with a \$20 million Built in Queensland Fund;
- (m) create a Queensland Industry Skills Council with regional skills boards to provide training that leads to jobs; and
- (n) supercharge the North West Minerals Province by boosting mineral exploration and reducing crippling energy costs with an energy audit.
