The committee has resolved, pursuant to standing orders 136(3) and 136(4), that the committee responsible for reporting on the Medicines and Poisons Bill be varied from the Health, Communities, Disability Services and Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Committee to the State Development, Natural Resources and Agricultural Industry Development Committee and that the committee report by 11 July 2019; and that the committee responsibility for reporting on the Therapeutic Goods Bill be varied from the Health, Communities, Disability Services and Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Committee to the State Development, Natural Resources and Agricultural Industry Development Committee and that the committee report by 11 July 2019.

The committee has resolved pursuant to standing order 194B that the Auditor-General's report to parliament No. 17 of 2018-19 titled *Managing consumer food safety in Queensland* be referred to the Health, Communities, Disability Services and Domestic and Family Violence Prevention Committee; and the Auditor-General's report to parliament No. 18 of 2018-19 titled *Local government: 2017-18 results of financial audits* be referred to the Economics and Governance Committee; and the Auditor-General's report to parliament No. 19 of 2018-19 titled *Education: 2017-18 results of financial audits* be referred to the Education, Employment and Small Business Committee.
