The report deals with allegations of an unauthorised disclosure of proceedings of the Economics and Governance Committee. The committee has recommended that the matter does not receive the further attention of the House due to the unlikely prospect of identifying the person or persons responsible. The committee has identified a number of learnings for portfolio committees in its report and urges all members to review the report accordingly. I commend it to the House.
