Portfolio Committee, Reporting Dates and Referral of Auditor-General's Reports

 **Hon. YM D'ATH** (Redcliffe—ALP) (Leader of the House) (5.18 pm): I seek to advise the House of the determinations made by the Committee of the Legislative Assembly at its meeting today. The committee has resolved, pursuant to standing order 136, that: the Health and Environment Committee report on the Health and Other Legislation Amendment Bill (No. 2) by 8 March 2024; the Community Support and Services Committee report on the Emergency Services Reform Amendment Bill, the Marine Rescue Queensland Bill and the State Emergency Service Bill by 15 March 2024; the Education, Employment and Training Committee report on the Work Health and Safety and Other Legislation Amendment Bill by 23 February 2024; the Economics and Governance Committee report on the Pharmacy Business Ownership Bill by 8 March 2024; the State Development and Regional Industries Committee report on the Summary Offences (Prevention of Knife Crime) and Other Legislation Amendment Bill by 1 February 2024; and the Legal Affairs and Safety Committee report on the Criminal Code and Other Legislation (Double Jeopardy Exception and Subsequent Appeals) Amendment Bill and the Forensic Science Queensland Bill by 19 February 2024.
