Will the Minister outline the following in relation to the State Emergency Service review conducted by Campbell Darby (a) the date the review commenced, (b) the date the review was provided to the Minister, (c) the date the review will be publicly released, (d) the total costs associated in commissioning and conducting the review and (e) will the Minister commit to implementing all the recommendations?

I am advised by Queensland Fire and Emergency Services:

- a) The State Emergency Service (SES) Review commenced on 9 September 2019.
- b) The SES Review Report was provided to me on 1 July 2020.
- c) The release date of the SES Review Report is currently under consideration.
- d) The cost of the SES Review was \$247,006.65.
- e) The Government is considering all the review recommendations.
