MRS L GERBER ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide (a) TransLink's (i) budgeted patronage, (ii) budgeted fare revenue, (iii) actual patronage, (iv) actual fare revenue (reported separately for the months of July and August 2021) and (b) any updated patronage and fare revenue projections for the remainder of this financial year (September 2021–June 2022)?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Currumbin for the question.

The COVID-19 pandemic has impacted public transport patronage across the world. In Queensland, patronage remains at approximately 70 per cent of pre-pandemic levels, after plummeting by as much as 80 per cent in 2020.

Because of the Palaszczuk Government's management of the health response to COVID-19, including only opening borders when it was safe to do so, we have been able to keep public transport running throughout Queensland.

In addition, the Palaszczuk Government is delivering an additional 175 weekly bus services and 105 weekly train services to support social distancing and increase confidence in the network.
