MS F SIMPSON ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister ensure Queensland Transport (a) make available details of the preserved CAMCOS (Beerwah to Maroochydore) heavy rail corridor to the Government agency responsible for Queensland Globe, (b) follow up to ensure it is transparently accessible for all to view on line as a proposed transport corridor and (c) report back to Parliament when it is done?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Maroochydore for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) provides information about projects that are planned or committed to the Queensland Government's State Planning Policy Interactive Mapping System (SPPIMS). This system is publicly available online at <https://spp.dsdip.esriaustraliaonline.com.au/geoviewer/map/planmaking> and the details of the CAMCOS corridor are currently published there. Refinements to the corridor will be reflected in SPPIMS as they are engineered and approved.
