MR J LISTER ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

### QUESTION:

With reference to the Regional Station Accessibility Upgrade Program—

Will the Minister provide the total budget, spend to date, and the spend for each year over the forwards for each station in the program along with the relevant QTRIP Investment IDs?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Southern Downs for the question.

The Palaszczuk Government is investing more than \$3.5 billion in rail projects in the forward estimates, supporting good jobs and delivering better services for Queenslanders.

Under the Regional Station Accessibility Upgrade Program planning for rail station upgrades has been announced at Rockhampton, Maryborough West, Bundaberg, Cairns and Townsville. The table below outlines the announced planning budgets and expenditure to 31 August 2022 and over the Forward Estimates.
