MR S MINNIKIN ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise if the government still supports the findings of the Western Brisbane Transport Network Study?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Chatsworth for the question.

The Western Brisbane Transport Network Strategy (WBTNS) was released in 2009, following a major transport planning study to investigate transport needs of western and northern Brisbane. It provided a transport vision to guide all levels of government in developing a fully integrated multi-modal approach to transforming the transport network of western and northern Brisbane.

The strategy has been formative in outlining the planning direction for the area and has informed a number of subsequent planning studies and transport plans, including the South East Queensland (SEQ) Regional Transport Plans (RTPs).

The SEQ RTPs provide a contemporary blueprint for Queensland's future transport system at the local level, guiding state and local government planning priorities over a 15-year horizon. The SEQ RTPs will guide planning priorities for the north-western Brisbane area. The WBTNS was considered in their development.
