# MR R STEVENS ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON M BAILEY)—

## QUESTION:

With reference to the Minister's advice in Estimates Hearing Question on Notice No. 13 that a number of QTRIP projects have been moved to the 'Other Works' section on page 131 of QTRIP 2022–23 to 2025–26—

Will the Minister list all projects funded in the Other Works section including (a) the project name, (b) which 'Investment name' item the project is funded under, (c) the project cost (reported separately by year of expenditure) and (d) if the item was previously listed in QTRIP with its own Investment ID?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mermaid Beach for the question.

The Palaszczuk Government is delivering its seventh record transport and roads infrastructure program in a row, as detailed in the *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program* (QTRIP) 2022–23 to 2025–26, which outlines \$29.7 billion in investment over the next four years and is estimated to support an average of 25,200 direct jobs over the life of the program.

QTRIP provides transparency about current and planned investment in transport infrastructure across Queensland over the next four years.

QTRIP is a complex and dynamic program, with fluctuations year-on-year as projects and programs progress through their development lifecycle.
