**DR M ROBINSON ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON B MELLISH)—**

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise how many bus services serving Redland City residents have been cancelled in the last three months (reported separately by date and route number)?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Oodgeroo for the question.

The Department of Transport and Main Roads' (TMR) delivery partner Transdev—which services the Redland City area—has been experiencing driver shortages due to illness, resignations and driver availability. Unfortunately, this has resulted in trip cancellations.

A total of 810 Transdev services were cancelled from 1 December 2023 to 28 February 2024 (of which 414 were cancelled due to Protected Industrial Actions). There were 39, 269 and 502 cancelled trips in December 2023, January 2024 and February 2024 respectively. This means 99.09 per cent (December 2023), 98.01 per cent (January 2024) and 96.57 per cent (February 2024) of monthly scheduled trips were completed for this period.
