MS F SIMPSON ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON B MELLISH)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of Taxi Subsidy Scheme cards issued for able-bodied persons and the disabled (wheelchair) persons since 2019 (reported separately by year) in Queensland and the Sunshine Coast Region?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Maroochydore for the question.

The Miles Government continues to provide transport support for people with disability through the Taxi Subsidy Scheme (TSS) to ensure they can undertake everyday activities, travel to medical appointments and stay connected with family, friends and the community.

TSS cards are issued to new members and to existing members who have renewed their membership, lost, misplaced or seek additional cards. TSS membership periods can vary up to a maximum of five years so the number of TSS cards issued per year is not a true representation of the scheme's membership.

Instead, the data outlined below provides the total number of active TSS memberships as at the end of each financial year, reported for the whole of Queensland and Sunshine Coast area only, split by wheelchair and non-wheelchair memberships.

NOTE: The data provided below represents live data extracted from the TSS Customer Relationship Management System, as at 21 June 2024.
