**HON S MILES** ASKED **MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS**  
(**HON B MICKELBERG**)—

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the patronage data for the Gold Coast Light Rail for the last three financial years (2022–23 to 2024–25), including (a) how many users ‘tapped on’ at each station, (b) the number of users transferring from a Gold Coast Light Rail service to a bus route at Broadbeach South station, Broadbeach and (c) the number of users transferring from a bus route at Broadbeach South station, Broadbeach to a Gold Coast Light Rail service?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

- (a) The number of users who ‘tapped on’ at each Gold Coast Light Rail (GCLR) station for the last three financial years (2022–23 to 2024–25) is provided in the following table.
