QUESTION:

MR LANGBROEK asked the Minister for Environment, Local Government, Planning and Women (Ms Boyle)—

With reference to the fire management of Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service parks and forests:

What was the actual total area of “burn off” achieved for each of 2002-03, 2003-04 and year to date 2004-05 (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

Planned burns implemented by the Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service are as follows:

2002-03	406,403 hectares
2003-04	525,000 hectares
2004-05	325,000 hectares (year to date)
