

## Question on Notice

MR QUINN asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR LUCAS)—

QUESTION:

Will he provide the total number of warnings and the total number of infringement notices (reported separately) issued by transit officers for 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 (year to date) (reported separately).

On 1 July, TransLink introduced a new integrated fares and ticketing system. As this involved significant changes for the traveling public, a moratorium on the issuing of ticketing related fines, except for blatant cases of fare evasion, was introduced.
