MR WELLINGTON asked the Minister for Police and Corrective Services (MS SPENCE) -

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the staff working at the Nambour Police Station and the limited office space and toilet facilities available to them – Has planning started on providing additional office and toilet facilities at the station; if so when will the additional facilities be available to the staff?

**ANSWER:**

This Government is committed to improving and updating police facilities throughout the State.

Work has commenced to develop options to upgrade the Nambour Police Station, including a new fitout of the existing station and the installation of a demountable building at the rear of the existing station. Once the most appropriate option is determined, works will commence.

In the longer-term, a replacement for the Nambour Police Station is included in the Police Service's 10 Year Capital Investment Strategic Plan. However a replacement of this station is unlikely within the next 3 years.
