MR REEVES asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTTALL) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Health and Community Care (HACC) funding services –

Will he outline recent announcements of HACC funding for services in the Mansfield Electorate?

ANSWER:

The Home and Community Care Program (HACC) is a national joint Australian Government/State Government funded program. It provides a range of basic maintenance and support services which allow people to be more independent at home and in the community. HACC eligible clients are the frail aged, younger people with disabilities, and their carers.

The Mansfield electorate will receive additional HACC operating funding of \$223,000 and capital funding of \$60,000, increasing the total HACC funding in the Mansfield electorate to \$1.7M. The three service providers in the Mansfield area to receive additional funding are:

- Flexi Care who will provide additional domestic assistance, social support, respite care services;
- the South East HACC Network Podiatry Project who will provide additional allied Health services; and
- Mt Gravatt In-home and Respite Support who will provide additional domestic assistance services.
