MR BRISKEY asked the Minister for Education and Minister for the Arts (Ms Bligh) -

QUESTION:

Will she outline the details regarding the proposed removal of the preschool from its present site to the primary school site in Agnes Street, Birkdale?

ANSWER:

Department of Education and the Arts is currently planning the relocation of the Birkdale State Preschool Centre to the Birkdale State School Site.

A preliminary design for the proposed new accommodation has been prepared.

The general scope of the relocation is the fit out of an existing two storey teaching block (Block D) at the primary school, into a preschool.

The areas to be included in the fit-out include:

- General Learning Areas (x2)
- Practical Learning Area
- Teacher Work Area
- Storage space
- Learning Area and
playspace

The estimated total cost of this project is \$450 000.

It is anticipated that the work will be completed for the start of the 2005 school year.
