MR BRISKEY asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTTALL) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Health and Community Care (HACC) funding for community assistance programs –

How has the Cleveland Electorate benefited from the recent HACC funding round?

ANSWER:

The Home and Community Care Program (HACC) is a national joint Australian Government/State Government funded program. It provides a range of basic maintenance and support services which allow people to be more independent at home and in the community. HACC eligible clients are the frail aged, younger people with disabilities, and their carers.

The Cleveland Electorate will receive additional HACC operating funding of \$234,000 and capital funding of more than \$25,000. The three service providers in the Cleveland electorate to receive additional funding are:

- St Luke's Nursing Service in Redlands who will provide additional allied health services;
- Redlands Shire Council Day Respite Care Centre who will provide additional centre based day care activities including outings; and
- Redland Shire Home Assist Secure who will provide additional home maintenance services.
