Asked on 19 May 2004

MR ROWELL asked the Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Relations (MR BARTON)—

### QUESTION:

With reference to the 1998-99 and 2003-04 financial years—

Will he provide the total number of casual, part-time and temporary employees by position and classification within each of his departments and agencies?

### ANSWER:

The total number of full-time equivalent casual, temporary part-time, temporary full-time and permanent part-time employees within the Department of Employment, Training and Industrial Relations (DETIR) in 1998-99; and the Departments of Employment and Training and Industrial Relations in 2003-04 is as follows:
