MR CHOI asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTTALL) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Health and Community Care (HACC) funding–

Which organisations have received funding since 2001 and what are the details of the funding?

ANSWER:

The Home and Community Care Program (HACC) is a national joint Australian Government/State Government funded program. It provides a range of basic maintenance and support services which allow people to be more independent at home and in the community. HACC eligible clients are the frail aged, younger people with disabilities, and their carers.

The following service providers are located in the Capalaba Electorate:

- Blue Care Redlands;
- Meals on Wheels Capalaba;
- Bayside Respite Centre; and
- Bridges Friday Night Respite Service.

There may be services delivered in the electorate by service providers who are not physically located in the electorate.

Since January 2001 the Capalaba Electorate has been paid HACC operating funds of \$4.8M and non operating funds of \$0.1M.

There has been a 47.6% increase in HACC operating funds to the electorate since 2000-01.
