MISS SIMPSON asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTALL)-

QUESTION:

When and how will the State Government consult with the Sunshine Coast communities about its promised new community health facility to ensure it is located where the majority of people can access it with ease?

ANSWER:

It is important to note that planning for the centre is in its earliest stages. The District Health Council will be expected to play a leading role in undertaking community engagement in relation to this project. Processes are also being developed to ensure input from non government organisations that may have an interest in providing services in or near the proposed centre. Importantly a whole of Government perspective will also be pursued with the early identification of other departments' interests in working with Queensland Health in the provision of comprehensive services to the Sunshine Coast community.
