

**Question on Notice
No. 614
Asked on 15 June 2004**

MR MCARDLE asked the Minister for State Development and Innovation (MR McGRADY) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Investment Incentives Scheme —

- (1) What is the total value of Government assistance granted via this scheme (by cash, payroll tax concession, stamp duty concession, land tax concession and other avenues) for 2001-02, 2002-03 and 2003-04?
- (2) What was the name of each corporation/company which has been successful in receiving assistance under this scheme for 2001-02, 2002-03 and 2003-04?
- (3) What was the type of assistance granted (by cash, payroll tax concession, stamp duty concession, land tax concession and other avenues) under this scheme for each corporation/company for 2001-02, 2002-03 and 2003-04?

ANSWER:

- (1) The total value of Government assistance granted via the Queensland Investment Incentives Scheme for 2001-02 was \$10.5 million, the number of new jobs generated was 1,010 and the capital investment was \$87 million.

In 2002-03 the value of assistance was \$14.6 million, the number of new jobs generated was 1,920 and the capital investment was \$56 million.

In 2003-04 the value of assistance was \$20.9 million, the number of new jobs generated was 1,958 and the capital investment was \$87 million.

- (2) The names of the corporations and companies assisted under the Queensland Investment Incentives Scheme are listed in the table below.
- (3) The type of assistance for each corporation and company assisted is also shown in the table below.

Information shown for 2001-02 and 2002-03 has been previously released in Departmental Annual Reports. Information shown for 2003-04 has not yet been released by way of Annual Report but has been referred to in other news releases.
