MR ENGLISH asked the Minister for Local Government, Planning and Women
(MS DESLEY BOYLE)–

QUESTION:

Has any direction ever been issued by the State Government to any local government in relation to “taking” population growth?

ANSWER:

To the best of my Department’s knowledge the State Government has not issued any direction to any local government in relation to taking population growth.

Population planning figures for local governments as a basis for future planning and management of growth in South-east Queensland have been used in the development of previous Regional Frameworks for Growth Management in this region. This last occurred in 2000.

These population planning figures were the agreed resident population levels which were used by agencies for planning purposes and were based on population projections for local government areas produced by my Department.
