MR MCARDLE asked the Minister for Police and Corrective Services (MS SPENCE) –

**QUESTION**

With reference to the operation of speed cameras in Queensland -

- (1) How many speed cameras were operational in Queensland (by police region)?
- (2) What was the total hours of speed camera operation (by financial year)?
- (3) What was the total number of offences recorded (by financial year)?
- (4) What was the total number of approved speed camera operating sites?
- (5) How many police officers were recorded as traffic camera operators in the Integrated Traffic Camera System for 2001-02, 2002-03 and 2003-04?

**ANSWER**

- (1) Information in relation to the number of speed cameras that are operational in Queensland is contained in the Queensland Police Service Annual Report.
- (2) Information in relation to the total hours of speed camera operation by financial year is contained in the Queensland Police Service Annual Report.
- (3) Information in relation to the total number of offences is contained in the Queensland Police Service Statistical Review.
- (4) Information in relation to the number of approved speed camera operating sites is contained in the Queensland Police Service Annual Report.
- (5) In July 2003, there were 696 certified speed camera operators. As at 21 June 2004, there were 612 certified speed camera operators. The Queensland Police Service has conducted a 'train the trainer' course that will allow further training to be provided in order to increase the number of certified operators throughout the State.
