Mr Roberts asked the Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Relations  
**(Mr Barton):**

**QUESTION:**

Will he outline the type, scope, funding allocation, organisation funded and outcomes of employment programs targeting indigenous unemployed people in the Nudgee Electorate?

**ANSWER:**

Since 1 October 1998 under the *Breaking the Unemployment Cycle* initiative 96 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people have been assisted under four Community Employment Programs in the Nudgee Electorate with funding totalling \$377 710. Of the 96 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders assisted, 68 obtained jobs after completion of the project. (A summary of the type, scope, funding allocation, organisations funded and job outcomes is contained at **Attachment 1.**)

Under the Public and Private Sector Programs, employers located in the Nudgee Electorate have assisted a total of nine apprentices/trainees into jobs at a total funding commitment of \$78 000. A further 25 individuals who live in the Nudgee Electorate have been funded for an apprenticeship or traineeship at a total cost of \$374 700.
