

**QUESTION ON NOTICE**

**NO. 827**

**Asked on 18 August 2004**

MR PURCELL asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR LUCAS)—

QUESTION:

(1) Will he provide the average number of weekday commuters at (a) Murarrie Rail Station, (b) Cannon Hill Rail Station, (c) Morningside Rail Station and (d) Norman Park Rail Station?

(2) What car parking facilities are available at each of these stations and what is their vehicle capacity?

(3) Which of these stations provides access for disabled people, parents with children in prams and strollers and people with walking difficulties?

ANSWER:

I thank the member for his questions about weekday commuters, park and ride facilities at various rail stations and access to stations for persons with disabilities.

(1) Daily average number of weekday journeys from the following stations:

(2) What car parking facilities are available at each of these stations and what is their vehicle capacity?

<b>Location</b>	
Norman Park station	114
Morningside station	142
Cannon Hill station	165
Murarrie station	51

(3) Which of these stations provides access for disabled people, parents with children in prams and strollers and people with walking difficulties?

<b>Location</b>	<b>Ramp access to Platforms (although not fully compliant with Disability Standards)</b>
Norman Park station	Ramp access to both platforms with subway and overhead footbridge.
Morningside station	Ramp access to both platforms and overhead footbridge.
Cannon Hill station	Ramp access to both platforms from Barrack Road level crossing. Overhead footbridge also at Cannon Hill.
Murarrie station	Ramp access to one platform with overhead bridge.
