Mr Hayward asked the Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Relations

QUESTION:

Under the pilot project “Get Set for Work” currently operating in the Caboolture Shire, will he advise if an outreach will be established to service the Narangba/Burpengary area?

ANSWER:

The “Get Set for Work” pilot project conducted by the Caboolture Area Youth Service is being well received by early young school leavers aged 15-17 years.

With the full implementation of the *Education and Training Reforms for the Future* in 2006, funding for the program delivery of “Get Set for Work” will be more widely available. However, delivery of services will always be based on areas of highest priority.

Discussions are continuing with the Caboolture Area Youth Service to investigate how clients from Narangba/Burpengary area can be accommodated. The method of delivery of services to the community has not been decided at this stage.
