MR FRASER asked the Minister for Transport and Main Roads (MR LUCAS) -

QUESTION:

When will the construction commence on installing signals to improve pedestrian safety and improve traffic throughput at McGregor Terrace, Bardon?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Mount Coot-tha for the question.

\$300,000 has been allocated for the project to improve pedestrian safety, by replacing the existing zebra crossing with traffic signals on Macgregor Terrace at Bardon.

This project is on track to be constructed this financial year, in line with the currently approved Roads Implementation Program (2004-05 to 2008-09). This is in response to the safety concerns raised by Mr Fraser, local businesses and pedestrians who regularly use the pedestrian crossing.

The tender has been assessed and financial approval is being finalised.

It is expected that work will commence in late April 2005 with construction to take approximately six (6) weeks.
