MR SPRINGBORG asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTTALL)-

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the qualifications and assessment of overseas trained doctors—

- (1) How many overseas trained doctors had their qualifications assessed by the Queensland Medical Board in 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 to date (reported separately)?
- (2) For those listed in (1), how many were assessed as (a) suitable or (b) unsuitable for employment in areas of need appointments in Queensland in 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05 to date (reported separately)?
- (3) For those listed in (2), at which tertiary institution or overseas medical facility were each of these doctors trained?
