MR ROBERTS asked the Minister for Employment, Training and Industrial Relations (**Mr Barton**):

QUESTION:

With reference to the Nudgee Electorate:

Will he outline, for each financial year of this term of the Beattie Labor Government, the following details of each funding grant under the Breaking the Unemployment Cycle (BUC) initiative

- (a) BUC program;
- (b) Funded organisation;
- (c) Financial contribution by State Government;
- (d) Financial or in-kind contributions by other parties;
- (e) Nature/scope of project; and
- (f) Expected or desired outcomes?

ANSWER:

For the current Beattie Labor Government term there have been four initiatives in the Nudgee Electorate under the Breaking the Unemployment Cycle program.

Two were funded under the **Community Jobs Plan – Employment Assistance**
