Mrs SCOTT asked the Minister for Public Works, Housing and Racing (MR SCHWARTEN) –

QUESTION:

- (1) How many homes have been upgraded under the Urban Renewal Program in the Woodridge Electorate in this term of government and at what cost?
- (2) How many homes were upgraded during the 2001-04 term and at what cost?
- (3) What has been the cost of general maintenance for department homes in this term?
- (4) What was the cost of general maintenance during 2001-04?

ANSWER:

(1) From February 2004 to April 2005, 31 public housing dwellings were upgraded under the Urban Renewal Program in the Woodridge Electorate at a cost of \$1.8m.

(2) From February 2001 to the end of January 2004, approximately 212 upgrades were commenced at a cost of \$6.99m.

(3) The cost of general maintenance in the Woodridge Electorate from February 2004 to April 2005 was \$5.089m.

(4) The cost of general maintenance in the Woodridge Electorate from February 2001 to January 2004 was \$11.053m.
