MRS SCOTT ASKED THE DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR SPORT (MR MACKENROTH)—

QUESTION:

- (1) Will he outline the full amount allocated to Logan City organisations in the last financial year from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF)?
- (2) What are the organisations in the Woodridge Electorate which have received funding from the GCBF in this financial year and the amounts involved?

ANSWER:

- (1) \$929,874 was allocated through 58 grants in the Logan City area in the last financial year from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund.
