

**Question on Notice
No. 773
Asked on 24 May 2005**

MISS SIMPSON asked the Minister for Health (MR NUTTALL)—

QUESTION:

With reference to his answer to Question on Notice No. 774 on 18 June 2004 in relation to health services on the Sunshine Coast in which he stated “Queensland Health has recently engaged a project officer to undertake some of the community and service provider consultation required to plan the services that may be provided from this campus”—

- (1) Who was engaged as a project officer and when?
- (2) How much was this person paid?
- (3) What organisations and individuals did this person consult with and when?
- (4) Will he table their report?

ANSWER:

(1) The Nursing Director Community and Service Manager Adult Health, QE II Hospital and Health Service District was seconded to the role of Project Officer, Community Campus Developments from July to December 2004.

(2) The project officer was paid according to award requirements.

(3) Organisations external to Queensland Health consulted were:
